



The Cabaret's success in developing the Irish language music industry, and promoting new and old Irish language music has seen it invited to Ireland's top festivals, Electric Picnic, Fleadh Feirste, Féile Oriel and now for a specially curated event at Donegal's own Féile an Earagail. The eclectic range of performances includes everything from Traditional, Rock and Reggae music, to indigenous Rap, Sean Nós singing and dancing by guests from across Ireland and further afield.

Following their first performance in Derrybeg Hall on the 10th January 1932, they toured extensively throughout the thirties to the early sixties and were instrumental in the opening of the Amharclann Ghaoth Dobhair in 1961.

This year's festival performance features the presentation of four one act comedies, reflecting

life, love, marriage and death: "Peadar ag an Dochtúir", "An Cleamhnas", "Fear a phós Balbhán" and the short one act farce "Tá sé, Níl sé". Directed by Tomás Mac Giolla Bhríde, these hugely popular plays feature a cast of well known actors, familiar to audiences from their performances in many TG4 programmes, including CU Burn, Gleann Ceo, FFC, Rós na Rún and Rásaí na Gaillimhe among others.
