Donegal finger-picking guitarist and singer Muireann Bradley, who rose to fame following her show-stopping appearance on Jools Holland's Annual Hootenanny on New Year's Eve 2023, delights in interpreting and performing the music of the early blues masters, always putting her own unique stamp on the tunes.

The Ballybofey native, who primarily performs country, ragtime and Piedmont-style blues from the 1920s and 1930s, released her debut album I Kept These Old Blues to wide acclaim in December 2023.






